 Mrs. Sousa-Dias' Grade 9 science class found a fun way to observe chemical and physical change for their chemistry summative - by baking cookies!

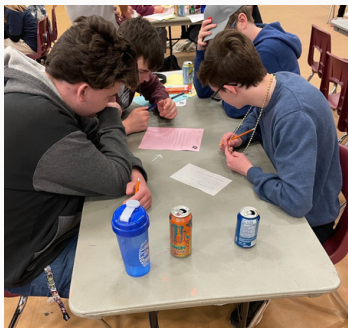

Students in all grades came out for a day of fun, leadership, and team-building at the Napanee Roller Rink!

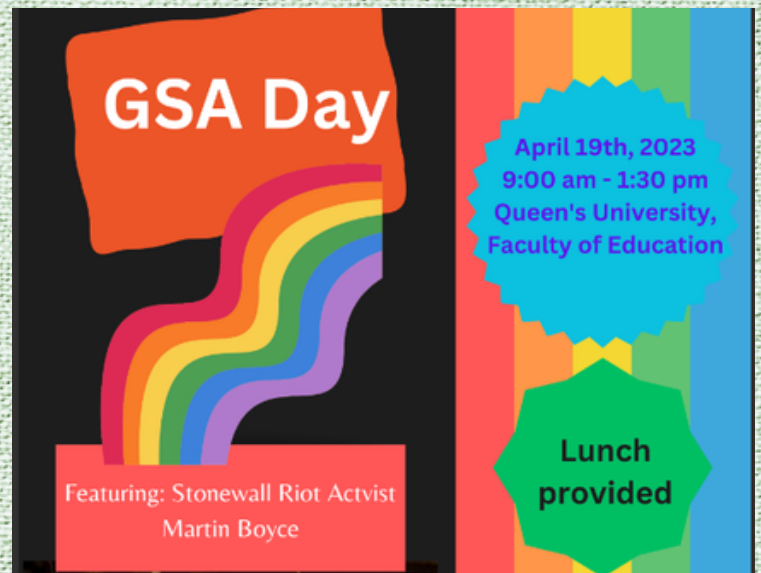

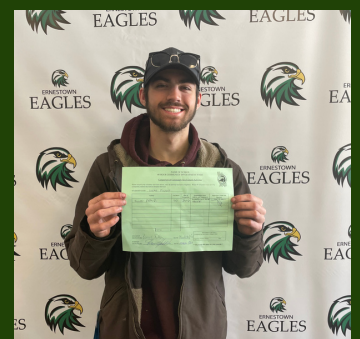
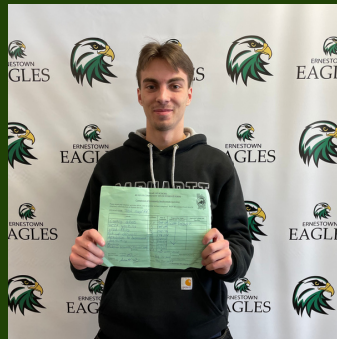
